


Hover House presents an architectural structure that experiments with gravity. Pranala showed that concrete, which usually seems heavy, can be designed in such a way as to look effortlessly light. Pranala has consistently maintained its principles in building this residential place by having neat grids. The Tostem Grants installed in the living room fit perfectly at Hover House as its frame allows the grid to be maintained. When the sliding doors are closed, the details are integrated into one line, creating a sleek grid that aligns with the concept. In addition, the Tostem Grants give a smooth transition from indoor to outdoor and vice versa. This supports another of Pranala's signature principles: to create a natural relationship between indoor and outdoor areas. For Hover House, Pranala intentionally chose the light-colored Shine Grey frame to balance the overall interior and exterior looks so no detail has a heavier feel than another
